Offers superb cleaning performance for the most difficult bonnet and traffic lane cleaning tasks. Powerful solvents and soil solubilizers remove even ground-in dirt from carpet fibers.

- High performance bonnet cleaner / Cleans even heavily soiled carpet and traffic lanes effectively to save time and labor
- Dual Purpose / Can be used as a bonnet cleaner and a traffic lane pre-spray.

- Contains water soluble solvents / Rapidly penetrates oil, grease and dry soils
- · Not recommended for use on stain resistant carpeting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ENDURE™ is a highly concentrated bonnet / traffic lane cleaner for use in severe soil conditions. Professionally formulated, it affords exceptionally economical dilutions that reduce cleaning costs. Effective for carpets made from nylon, rayon, olefin, wool, and other synthetic and natural fibers. Restores carpets to a new level of cleanliness and beauty. Contains no optical brighteners which can damage carpet fibers. Not recommended for use on stain resistant carpeting.

BONNET CLEANING

- 1) Pretest carpet for colorfastness in an inconspicuous area.
- 2) Remove furniture and dry vacuum thoroughly.
- In a pump-up or pressure sprayer, mix ENDURE™ solution according to the recommendations listed below.
- 4) Spray diluted cleaning solution onto carpet in 6' x 12' sections.
- 5) For heavy soiling conditions let solution dwell for 10 minutes.
- Immerse bonnet in water and wring out thoroughly, then place bonnet on machine.

Scrub carpet and change bonnet pad as it becomes soiled.
 Bonnet Dilution Chart

Light Soils	1:64 (2 oz. per gallon of water)
Moderate Soils	1:32 (4 oz. per gallon of water)
Heavy Soils	1:16 (8 oz. per gallon of water)

TRAFFIC LANE CLEANING

- In a pump-up or pressure sprayer, dilute ENDURE™ at a rate of 1:16 (8 oz per gallon of water).
- Spray onto traffic lanes at a rate of 500-600 sq. ft. per gallon of diluted product. DO NOT OVERWET THE CARPET.
- 3) Allow to set for 5-10 minutes.
- 4) Extract, Brush/Bonnet as desired.

NOTE: Due to the variety of carpeting materials this product should be tested at recommended use dilution in an inconspicuous area. Use clean cloth or sponge for application and if test area indicates bleeding, color removal, carpet shrinkage or deterioration of adhesive, do not use.


